



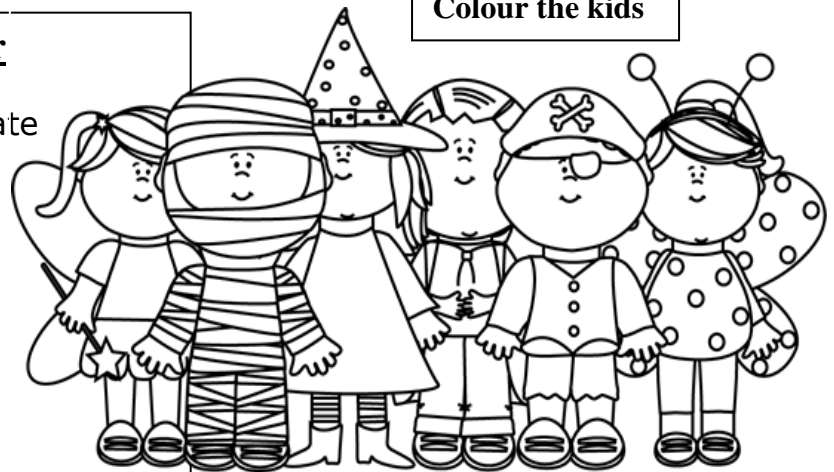
Halloween traditions
