Thanksgiving is a festival celebrated by Americans on the 4th Thursday of November. They commemorate the Pilgrims survived the first winter in America



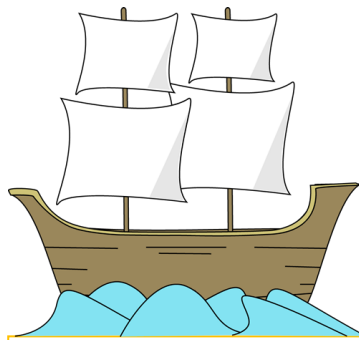
Native Americans were original inhabitants of North America.

Cornucopia - a horn full of fruit and vegetables which symbolizes the first Thanksgiving harvest.



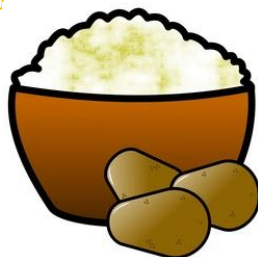
Mayflower was the ship that transported Pilgrims from England to America in 1620.



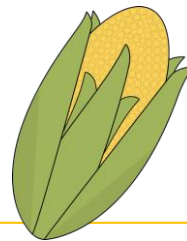
Thanksgiving dinner is a special dinner eaten by Americans on the 4th Thursday of November each year.
