They have stories to tell and interesting games to play.

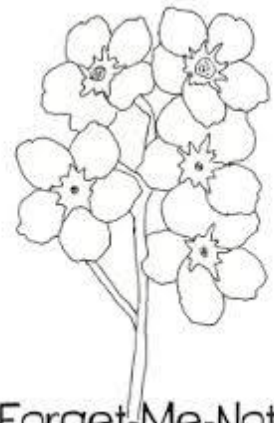
In America, National Grandparents Day was proclaimed in 1978 by President Jimmy Carter. America celebrates this holyday on the first Sunday of September.
