It's November 5th , 1605.

A Catholic called **Guy Fawkes** and his friends try to kill the Protestant King James I. They want to blow up the Houses of Parliament when the king is inside.

They put barrels of gunpowder in the cellars of the palace, but the King receives an anonymous letter and his soldiers arrest Guy Fawkes and he is executed.



Every year, on November 5th English people

commemorate Guy Fawkes. Children make puppets with old clothes and ask “a penny for the guy”. With the money they receive, they buy fireworks and sparkles. In the evening the puppets are burnt in bonfires, people look at fireworks and eat sausages and toffee apples.
