

Love-Like-Hate + Verb -ing

The verbs **love, like and hate** are verbs which express likes and dislikes. They are usually followed by a gerund (verb + **-ing**)

For example:

I **like** swimming in the summer.

My brother **loves** playing tennis.

They **hate** studying German.
